Issues Fixed & Modification

v5.5.0.39

- Added a NAS connection retry mechanism after system bootup to enhance stability across different network environments.
- Fixed "The storage settings page could not be accessed or modified if the Station was unable to connect to the NAS."
- Fixed "Constantly switching between the web admin and online director page during a live stream could eventually crash the streaming function."
- Modified the workflow with Panopto webcast events to convert a live event into an on-demand video right after the event ends.
- Fixed "The system failed to retry uploading videos to Panopto/Opencast after a network disconnection of about 1 minute."
- Fixed "Stations only uploaded mixed video MP4 files if there were any non-English characters in the video source name."
- Fixed "The advanced settings for uploading to Opencast would reset to default once the "..." button was clicked."
- Fixed "TCP control failed after receiving a command with a length of over 256 bytes."
- Fixed "A false alarm issue where a GUI error message was shown after clicking the snapshot button on the online director page."
- Hard fix for "When scheduling recordings using Kaltura, Stations did not start and stop recording according to the event times."
  - \* This issue was found in early April 2024 (around 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2024) and was fixed in Kaltura SaaS version Tucana-20.11.0, tested on 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2024.
